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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 50,000 GALLON GROUND STORAGE RESERVOIR; AUTHORIZING THE RELOCATION OF PIPES AND METERS AND WORK ON PUMPS ON THE WATER LINE TO MERKEL.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of a 50,000 gallon ground storage reservoir to be constructed on the water line to the City of Merkel; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council recommends that funds be expended for the construction of a 50,000 gallon ground storage reservoir; the relocation of pipes and meters; work on pumps and engineering fees; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on July 19, 1966, said bids being as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Perry Shankle Company in the total amount of Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$9,500.00) is the lowest responsible bid and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the bid of Perry Shankle Company, for the construction of a 50,000 gallon ground storage reservoir in the total amount of \$9,500.00 be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted.

Section 2: That funds in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) be and are hereby appropriated from the Water Bond Fund for payment in the following manner: (a) construction of a ground storage tank \$9,500.00, (b) relocation of pipes and meters and work on pump \$4,500.00, (c) engineering fees \$1,000.00.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
