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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROLLERS AND ONE-WAY, 3-SECTION TRAFFIC SIGNALS MEETING SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.
