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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 23 TONS 16-4-4 ORGANIC BASE FERTILIZER, PELLETTIZED, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of 23 Tons 16-4-4 Organic Base Fertilizer, Pelletized, for the use of the City of Abilene; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


