A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE, AN ARCHITECTURAL AGREEMENT WITH WOODLIEF F. BROWN, ARCHITECT, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TENNIS CENTER TO BE SITUATED IN FAIR PARK, AN OFFICE BUILDING TO BE SITUATED IN CEDAR HILL CEMETERY AND REST ROOMS TO BE LOCATED AT NELSON PARK.

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 28th day of February, 1967, the qualified voters of the City of Abilene voted to authorize the issuance of General Obligation Bonds for the construction of various facilities within the City of Abilene, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board of the City of Abilene has interviewed local architects for the purpose of selecting an architect to design and to furnish general administration services for the construction of a Tennis Center to be situated in Fair Park, an Office Building to be situated in Cedar Hill Cemetery and Rest Rooms to be located at Nelson Park; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Parks and Recreation Board that Woodlief F. Brown, Architect, should be selected for the project, and, accordingly, it is the recommendation of the Parks and Recreation Board that the City Council select such Architect; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the agreement between the City of Abilene and Woodlief F. Brown, Architect, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto, be, and the same is hereby, in all things approved.

Section 2: That the Mayor be, and is hereby, authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Abilene.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
