A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE, AN ARCHITECTURAL AGREEMENT WITH LANDERS & CAMPBELL, ARCHITECTS - ENGINEERS, FOR THE REMODELING AND RENOVATION OF THE SEARS BUILDING SITUATED IN FAIR PARK FOR USE AS A CHILDREN'S THEATRE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and the Abilene Community Theatre have heretofore jointly agreed to remodel and renovate the Sears Building situated in Fair Park for use as a Children's Theatre; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board of the City of Abilene has interviewed local architects for the purpose of selecting an architect to design and to furnish general administration services for the remodeling and renovation of the Sears Building situated in Fair Park for use as a Children's Theatre; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Parks and Recreation Board that the firm of Landers & Campbell, Architects - Engineers, should be selected for the project, and, accordingly, it is the recommendation of the Parks and Recreation Board that the City Council select such firm; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the agreement between the City of Abilene and Landers & Campbell, Architects - Engineers, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto, be, and the same is hereby, in all things approved.

Section 2: That the Mayor be, and is hereby, authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Abilene.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
