A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) AIR COMPRESSOR FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of one (1) air compressor for the use of the City; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on June 13, 1966, said bids being as follows:
