A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO TENNIS COURTS
AT FAIR PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave notice, as required
by law, for bids for the construction of two Tennis Courts at Fair Park; and

WHEREAS, such bids were received and opened on July 11th, 1967, said bids
being as follows:

T. H. Carter	\$ 9,616.00
E. B. McCown	10,256.00
C. B. Oates Construction Company	11,420.00
Lee Cullen	8,364.66

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board of the City of Abilene has recom-
mended acceptance of the bid of Lee Cullen; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the bid of Lee Cullen is
the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted;
now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Lee Cullen, in the total amount of Eight Thou-
sand Three Hundred Sixty Four and 66/100 Dollars (\$8,364.66) be, and the same is
hereby, accepted and approved.

SECTION 2: That funds in the amount of Eight Thousand Three Hundred
Sixty Four and 66/100 Dollars (\$8,364.66) be, and the same are hereby, approp-
riated from the Park Bond Funds for the amount of such contract and architectural
fees.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute
a contract for the construction of two Tennis Courts at Fair Park.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
