now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the bid of T. H. Carter, in the total amount of Six Thou-
sand Two Hundred Seventy Four and No/100 Dollars (\$6, 274. 00) be, and the same is
hereby, accepted and approved.

SECTION 2: That funds in the amount of Six Thousand Two Hundred Seventy
Four and No/100 Dollars (\$6, 274. 00) be, and the same are hereby, appropriated
from the Park Bond Funds for the amount of such contract and architectural fees.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute
a contract for the construction of a Championship Tennis Court at Fair Park.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and
after its passage.
