

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ~~ONE~~ ^{TWO} GARDEN TRACTORS TO MEET SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice as required by law, for bids for the purchase of ~~one~~ ^{two} garden tractor, to meet specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on the 27th day of June, 1967:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Western Tractor Company, in the net amount of One Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Five and 40/100ths Dollars (\$1, 335. 40), is the lowest, responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Western Tractor Company for the purchase of ~~one~~ ^{two} garden tractors to meet specifications, in the net amount of One Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Five and 40/100ths Dollars (\$1, 335. 40), be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

SECTION 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to purchase such equipment from such firm.

SECTION 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
