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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDED A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TENNIS PRO-SHOP AT FAIR PARK; A REST ROOM AND CONCESSION BUILDING AT NELSON PARK, AND A CEMETERY OFFICE BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave notice, as required by law, for bids for the construction of a Tennis Pro-Shop at Fair Park, a Rest Room and Concession Building at Nelson Park, and a Cemetery Office Building; and

WHEREAS, such bids were received and opened on July 11th, 1967, said bids being as follows:

C. B. Oates Construction Company	\$ 60,575.00
Miller Building Company	59,000.00
E. B. McCown	57,245.00
C. Goldsmith	54,873.00
Gale Gabbart Construction Company	53,418.00

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board of the City of Abilene has recommended acceptance of the bid of Gale Gabbart Construction Company; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the bid of Gale Gabbart Construction Company is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Gale Gabbart Construction Company, in the total amount of Fifty Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen and No/100 Dollars (\$53,418.00) be, and the same is hereby, accepted and approved.


SECTION 2: That funds in the amount of Fifty Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen and No/100 Dollars (\$53,418.00) be, and the same are hereby, appropriated from the Park Bond Funds for the amount of such contract and architectural fees.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute a contract for the construction of a Tennis Pro-Shop at Fair Park, a Rest Room

and Concession Building at Nelson Park, and a Cemetery Office Building.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
