

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee of the West Central Texas Council of Governments met on this the 27th day of September, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the West Central Texas Council of Governments has voted to rent office space from the Mims Building in Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and to move out of the City Hall of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, on November 1, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the office space presently being used by the West Central Texas Council of Governments has been furnished by the City Government of the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the West Central Texas Council of Governments now is in a position to have it's office space outside of the City Hall of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and the Executive Committee of the West Central Texas Council of Governments should express their thanks to the City of Abilene for the courtesies extended to the Council of Governments during it's organization and first year of operation, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Committee of the West Central Texas Council of Governments that the City Government of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, be sent a copy of this resolution expressing the thanks of the West Central Texas Council of Governments for the office space furnished and for all the other courtesies shown the West Central Texas Council of Governments during it's organization and the first year of operation, and each member of the

Executive Committee joins in voting for such resolution and asks that a copy be furnished the City Government of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.
