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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE APPROVING THE BID OF INDUSTRIAL DISPOSAL SUPPLY FOR REFUSE CONTAINERS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PROMISSORY NOTE IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE BID IN PAYMENT OF SUCH REFUSE CONTAINERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice as required by law, for bids for the purchase of refuse containers; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

ABILENE:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Industrial Disposal Supply for refuse containers, at a total bid price of Twenty Four Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Eight and No/100 Dollars (\$24,888.00), be, and the same is hereby, in all things, accepted.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City of Abilene, a Promissory Note in the full amount of said bid.

SECTION 3: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to purchase such equipment from such firm.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
