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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE SALVAGE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ABILENE AND MARVIN E. NELSON.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and Marvin E. Nelson have heretofore, on the 1st day of October, 1965, entered into a contract providing that the said Marvin E. Nelson be granted salvage rights in the City of Abilene Disposal Area, which such contract was amended by agreement dated April 14th, 1966; and

WHEREAS, a strike of the Kennecott Copper Corp. has made it impossible for the said Marvin E. Nelson to market the salvage from the Abilene Disposal Area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and the said Marvin E. Nelson are agreeable to an amendment to the terms for payment by the said Marvin E. Nelson; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3 of said contract be amended to require the payment of One Hundred ~~Seventy~~^{Fifty} Dollars (\$1~~70~~⁵⁰.00) per month, plus Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per load of salvageable material removed from said disposal area during the term of such strike; and, after the cessation of such strike, to require the payment of either (A) Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$650.00) per month, or (B) One Hundred ~~Seventy~~^{Fifty} Dollars (\$1~~70~~⁵⁰.00) per month plus Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per load of salvageable material removed during such month, whichever (A or B) is greater.


SECTION 2: That such contract amendment be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute said amendment to such contract, a copy of which is attached hereto.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from
and after its passage.
