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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 8 - 1968 POLICE CARS AND 1 - 1968
SUBURBAN TYPE STATION WAGON, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE
BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice as
required by law, for bids for the purchase of eight (8) 1968 police cars and one
(1) 1968 suburban type station wagon, for use by the City of Abilene; and
WHEREAS, such bids, as set forth on the Tabulation of Bids, attached
hereto, were received and opened on the 19th day of December, 1967; and
WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bids of Gamble-
Chrysler Plymouth and International Harvester Company, hereinafter set forth,
are the lowest, responsible bids, meeting specifications, and should be accepted;
now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Gamble-Chrysler Plymouth in the net amount
of Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-three and 44/100 Dollars (\$20, 273. 44)
for Item No. 1 - eight (8) police cars, be, and the same is hereby in all things,
approved.


SECTION 2: That the bid of International Harvester Company in the net
amount of Three Thousand One Hundred Twenty-seven and 40/100 Dollars
(\$3, 127. 40) for Item No. 2 - one (1) station wagon, be, and the same is hereby
in all things, approved.

SECTION 3: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized
to purchase such items of equipment from such firms.

SECTION 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and
after its passage.
