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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE ALTERNATE BID OF HOBBS TRAILERS FOR TWO REFUSE TRANSFER TRAILERS, LESS TRADE-INS, AND, AS PAYMENT THEREFOR, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SUCH PROMISSORY NOTE AS MIGHT BE NECESSARY IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH PURCHASE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice as required by law, for bids for the purchase of two (2) seventy-five (75) cubic yard refuse compaction type transfer trailers, less trade-ins, for use by the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, such bids, as set forth on the Tabulation of Bids, attached hereto, were received and opened on the 3rd day of January, 1968; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the alternate bid of Hobbs Trailers is the lowest, responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted, and that, as payment for such purchase, the Mayor should be authorized to execute such Promissory Note as might be necessary in regard thereto; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the alternate bid of Hobbs Trailers, as shown by the attached Tabulation of Bids, for the purchase by the City of Abilene of two (2) seventy-five (75) cubic yard refuse compaction type transfer trailers, less trade-ins, be, and the same is hereby, in all things, accepted.




SECTION 3: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to purchase such equipment from such firm.
