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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE ALTERNATE BIDS OF INTERNATIONAL HARVESTER CO., FOR THE PURCHASE OF TRUCKS TO BE USED BY THE STREET AND REFUSE DISPOSAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PROMISSORY NOTE IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of four (4) Dump Trucks, three (3) Container Collection Trucks, and four (4) Refuse Packer Trucks, less trade-ins, for use by the Street and Refuse Disposal Departments of the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the bids, as set forth in detail on the attached Tabulation of Bids, were received and opened on the 16th day of April, A. D., 1968; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the alternate bids of International Harvester Co., to-wit: Four (4) Dump Trucks, \$25,442.96 - Three (3) Container Collection Trucks, \$25,971.87 - Four (4) Refuse Packer Trucks, \$22,525.00 - all with 462 cubic inch diesel engines and less trade-ins, are the lowest and best responsible bids, meeting specifications, and should be accepted, and that the Mayor should be authorized to execute a note, or notes, in connection with such purchases, not to exceed an aggregate amount of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the alternate bids of International Harvester Co., as hereinabove set forth, in the total amount of Seventy Three Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Nine and 83/100 Dollars (\$73,939.83), be, and are hereby, in all things, accepted and approved.

PART 2: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute a Promissory Note, or Notes, in connection with such purchases, not to exceed an aggregate amount of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00).

PART 3: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to consummate such transactions with such firm.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
