

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN AMENDED OR SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION WITH THE HOUSING AND HOME FINANCE AGENCY, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT OF 1964.

WHEREAS, the Housing and Home Finance Administrator is authorized to make grants for mass transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has heretofore submitted an application for a grant of such nature, on June 16th, 1966; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be beneficial to the general public to file an amendment or supplement to such application in order to acquire additional financial assistance under the Mass Transportation Act of 1964; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Manager is authorized to execute and file an amended or supplemental application on behalf of the City of Abilene, Texas, to aid in the financing of the acquisition of additional transit buses and the construction of a central transfer station within the City of Abilene.

PART 2: That the City Manager is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Housing and Home Finance Agency might require in connection with such amended or supplemental application.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
