

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING A BID FOR THE DISASSEMBLY, MOVING AND REASSEMBLING OF A STEEL BUILDING AND APPROPRIATING PARK BOND FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave notice, as required by law, for the disassembly, moving and reassembling of a steel building; and, WHEREAS, such bids were received and opened on August 14, 1968, said bids being as follows:

Bonine Construction Co.	\$2, 333. 65
H. E. Abbott & Sons, Inc.	\$2, 430. 00
Quality Steel Building Co.	\$2, 800. 00
Liking & Associates	\$3, 890. 00

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the bid of Bonine Construction Co. is the lowest and best responsible bid meeting specifications, and should be accepted; and,

WHEREAS, such building was acquired with Civic Center Bond Funds and the City Council is of the opinion that the fair market value of such building is Five Hundred (\$500. 00) Dollars, in which amount Civic Center Bond Funds should be reimbursed; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Bonine Construction Co. in the total amount of \$2, 333. 65 be accepted.

SECTION 2: That funds in the amount of \$2, 833. 65 be, and the same are hereby, appropriated from Park Bond Funds for the amount of such bid and reimbursement to Civic Center Bond Funds.

SECTION 3: That this resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
