

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) BUSES FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of two (2) buses for the use of the City; and,
WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on September 10, 1968, said bids being as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of GMC Truck and Coach Division in the total amount of Forty One Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty-six and 96/100 (\$41,386.96) Dollars is the lowest responsible bid and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TEXAS:


PART 1: That the bid of GMC Truck & Coach Division, for the purchase of two (2) buses, in the total amount of \$41,386.96, be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and accepted, contingent, however, upon the approval of an Urban Mass Transportation Grant, application for which is presently pending, from the Department of Housing and Urban Development to the City of Abilene in the amount of not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the purchase price of said buses.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, subject to the above contingency, authorized to purchase two (2) buses from said firm.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
