A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARING A CONTRACT FOR THE DEMOLITION OF THE OLD CITY HALL BUILDING TO HOBBS DEMOLISHING COMPANY, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAME.

WHEREAS, the only bid received and opened on the 8th day of October, 1968, was that of Hobbs Demolishing Company in the amount of Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-eight and No/100 (\$12, 948. 00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the bid of Hobbs Demolishing Company, in the amount of Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-eight and No/100 (\$12, 948. 00) Dollars, is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

PART 1: That the bid of Hobbs Demolishing Company, in the amount of Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-eight and No/100 (\$12, 948. 00) Dollars, be, and is hereby, in all things, accepted and approved.


PART 2: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute a contract with Hobbs Demolishing Company for such demolition.


PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
