A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CHAIN LINK FENCE, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR INSTALLATION AT THE "TEEN-AGE" BASEBALL FIELD IN OSCAR ROSE PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase and installation of chain link fence, meeting specifications, for the "Teen-Age" Baseball Field in Oscar Rose Park, for use by the City of Abilene; and


PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to make such purchase from said firm.
