

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FENCING, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE, AND APPROPRIATING PARK BOND FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice as required by law, for bids for the purchase of fencing, for use by the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the bids, as set forth on the Tabulation of Bids, attached hereto, were received and opened on the 27th day of May, A. D., 1969; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the base bid of Allied Fence Company, hereinafter set forth, is the lowest, responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the base bid of Allied Fence Company, in the net amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-eight and No/100 (\$1,298.00) Dollars be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That funds in the amount of \$1,298.00 be, and the same are hereby, appropriated from Park Bond Funds for the purchase of such fencing.

PART 3: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to purchase such fencing from said firm.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
