

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDED CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ABILENE WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT, WHICH AMENDED CONTRACT PROVIDES FOR AN URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL GRANT TO THE CITY OF ABILENE UNDER THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT OF 1964.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene applied for a grant under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964 with the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has approved the application of the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has required that an amended contract be executed in order that the City of Abilene receive the grant; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of the amended Urban Mass Transportation Capital Grant Contract is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Abilene that the City Manager should be authorized to execute the amended contract on behalf of the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute the amended Urban Mass Transportation Capital Grant Contract on behalf of the City of Abilene, Texas, which Capital Grant is to aid in the financing of a capital improvement project generally described as:

- (a) Purchase of twelve (12) new 35- passenger air conditioned buses.
- (b) The construction of a bus cleaning facility.
- (c) The purchase and installation of ride and designating signs for six buses.
- (d) The purchase of land and construction of a main terminal and transfer building including paving of a parking lot.
- (e). Furnishing and equipping the facility and contingencies.
