

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPOINT AN ASSISTANT CORPORATION COURT JUDGE.

WHEREAS, Mrs. Jo Jameson, Corporation Court Judge of Abilene, Texas, has been hospitalized and will not be able to act in her capacity for some time, and

WHEREAS this creates an emergency in that the Corporation Court should continue to function, and

WHEREAS the Abilene Bar Association has volunteered to furnish qualified lawyers to be Assistant Corporation Judges and to act as such until Mrs. Jo Jameson the Corporation Court Judge can resume her duties, and

WHEREAS Charles Erwin through July 10th; Dub Burke starts July 11th

and goes through July 18th; Charles Scarborough Starts July 21st and goes through July 25th; Malcolm Schultz starts ~~August 28th~~ and goes through August 1st; Don Seamster starts August 4th and goes through August 8th and Charles Erwin starts August 11th and goes through August 15th, ^{and} have agreed if needed, to be appointed as Assistant Corporation Judges and to act as

such without pay until the said Mrs. Jo Jameson, Corporation Court Judge of Abilene, Texas can resume her duties; and

WHEREAS it is the opinion of the City Council of Abilene, Texas, that there is a need for a qualified attorney to be Assistant Corporation Court Judge until such time that Mrs. Jo Jameson, the Corporation Court Judge can resume her duties and that the Mayor shall be authorized to appoint a qualified attorney to be an Assistant Corporation Court Judge; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That there is a need for an Assistant Corporation Court Judge to be appointed to enable the Corporation Court to operate.

Section 2: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to appoint an Assistant Corporation Court Judge until such time as the Corporation Court Judge of Abilene, Texas can resume her duties as such.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
