A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF WATER AND SEWER EQUIPMENT, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of one (1) Four inch Discharge Electric Submersible Pump, three (3) Liquid Level Regulators, one (1) Automatic Double Pump Control Center, one (1) Extra Discharge Connection, and one (1) Pump with 8 inch suction and 6 inch discharge complete with all auxiliary equipment and accessories, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on the 16th day of

July, A. D., 1969:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bids of Newman Company, in the total sum of Two Thousand One Hundred Ten and 30/100 Dollars (\$2, 110. 30), and the bid of Bowles and Edens Corporation, in the total sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-eight and 48/100 Dollars (\$1, 388. 48), are the lowest and best responsible bids meeting specifications for all of such items and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the bids of Newman Company, for the purchase of One (1) Four inch Discharge Electric Submersible Pump, Three (3) Liquid Level Regulators, One (1) Automatic Double Pump Control Center, and One (1) Extra Discharge Connection, in the total amount of Two Thousand One Hundred Ten and 30/00 Dollars, (\$2, 110. 30), be and the same are hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to make such purchases from said firms.

PART 3: That the bid of Bowles and Edens Corporation, for the purchase of One (1) Pump with 8 inch suction and 6 inch discharge complete with all auxiliary equipment and accessories, in the total amount of One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight and 48/100 Dollars (\$1, 388. 48), be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 4: That funds in the amount of One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight and 48/100 Dollars (\$1, 388. 48), be, and the same are hereby, appropriated from Sewer Bond Funds for the purchase of such items of equipment.

PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
