A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) AIR COMPRESSOR, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of one (1) Air Compressor, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on the 3rd day of September, A. D., 1969:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Chancey Equipment, in the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-five Dollars and No/100 (\$3,265.00), is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the bid of Chancey Equipment, for the purchase of One (1) Air Compressor, in the amount of Three Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-five Dollars and No/100 (\$3,265.00) be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to make such purchase from said company.
