

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CHAIN LINK FENCING AT LANDFILL AREA, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of Chain Link Fencing at Landfill Area, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on the 12th day of November, A. D., 1969:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Malone Fence Company, in the sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-eight Dollars (\$1,858.00) is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

PART 1: That the bid of Malone Fence Company, for the purchase of Chain Link Fencing at Landfill Area, in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-eight Dollars (\$1,858.00) be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to make such purchase from said company.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
