A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE EXPRESSING APPROVAL AND ENDORSING THE BUSINESS ALLIANCE FOR INTERCOLLEGIATE DEVELOPMENT CAMPAIGN WHICH BEGINS ON NOVEMBER 24, 1969, AND APPOINTING WALT GABE, PRESIDENT OF THE STUDENT BODY OF ABILENE CHRISTIAN COLLEGE, RALPH THORNHILL, PRESIDENT OF THE STUDENT BODY OF HARDIN-SIMMONS UNIVERSITY AND ED WILLIAMSON, PRESIDENT OF THE STUDENT BODY OF MCMURRY COLLEGE AS HONORARY CITY MANAGERS DURING THIS CAMPAIGN.

WHEREAS, Abilene Christian College, Hardin-Simmons University and McMurry College serve a vital need in the education field for our City and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, Abilene Christian College, Hardin-Simmons and McMurry College students and faculty members contribute greatly to Abilene's growth, culture and Christian beliefs; and

WHEREAS, the Business Alliance for Intercollegiate Development Campaign is necessary for the continuing operation, growth and success of Abilene Christian College, Hardin-Simmons University and McMurry College; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene herewith expresses its approval and endorses the Business Alliance for Intercollegiate Development in its campaign which begins November 24, 1969, and requests that all citizens contribute to and support this campaign to aid our three colleges which mean so much to our City.

PART 2: That Walt Gabe, Ralph Thornhill and Ed Williamson are hereby appointed Honorary City Managers during this campaign.
