

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FIFTEEN (15) 1970 POLICE CARS, TWO (2) 1970 POLICE DEPARTMENT STATION WAGONS, FOUR (4) 1970 PASSENGER CARS AND ONE (1) USED MOTORCYCLE, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of Fifteen (15) 1970 Police Cars, Two (2) 1970 Police Department Station Wagons, Four (4) 1970 Passenger Cars and One (1) Used Motorcycle, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,


TEXAS:
