A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMOTIVE PARTS, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE SHOP OF THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice as required by law for bids for the purchase of an automotive brake shoe grinder, brake drum lathe and brake drum micrometer, meeting specifications, for use by the Shop of the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on the 6th day of January, 1970:

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Boyd Smith Auto Supply Company for One Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-five Dollars Thirty-eight Cents (\$1,895.38) is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the bid of Boyd Smith Auto Supply Company for the purchase of the above described equipment and for the amount shown be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to make such purchases from said company.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
