

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE ABILENE-TAYLOR COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITIES OF OBTAINING A GRANT FOR THE CONTINUATION OF AN ADDITION TO THE ABILENE HEALTH CENTER BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the Abilene-Taylor County Health Department desires to expand their facilities by constructing an addition to their existing building; and

WHEREAS, there are no funds available for such construction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that there is a possibility of securing a grant from the Hill-Burton Program or from other programs for this construction; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

PART 1: That the Abilene-Taylor County Board of Health is hereby authorized to investigate the possibility of securing a grant from the Hill-Burton Program or any other program to construct an addition to the present Abilene Health Center Building.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
