AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) SEVEN UNIT GANG TYPE MOWER

PART 1: That the bid of Goldthwaites of Texas, for the purchase of one (1) Seven Unit Gang Type Mower, less the trade-in, in the amount of Five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars and NO/100 (\$5,997.00) is the lowest and best responsible bid and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.
