A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF SIXTEEN (16) LAWNMOWERS, MEETING  
SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of sixteen (16) lawnmowers, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on the 30th day of March, 1970;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS  
PART 1: That the bid of Goldthwaite's of Texas, for the purchase of sixteen (16) lawnmowers, in the amount of Two Thousand and Ninety-Five Dollars and NO/100ths (\$2095. 00) is the lowest and best responsible bid, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby, authorized to make such purchase from said company.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
