WHEREAS, the City of Abilene on June 25, 1970, by Ordinance Number 479 levied a hotel and motel occupancy tax to raise revenue to promote tourism and conventions for the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, the representatives of the hotel, motel and restaurant organizations requested that the City of Abilene enter into a contract or an agreement with an agency outside of the City of Abilene government to administer and manage the funds made available by this tax; and

WHEREAS, the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Abilene has established a Convention and Visitors Bureau which has agreed to manage the tax funds in accordance with the requirements set out in Ordinance Number 479; and

WHEREAS, the City Council feels that this agreement will be advantageous to the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the management agreement with the Convention and Visitors Bureau, a copy of which is attached hereto, be, and the same is hereby in all things, approved and affirmed.

PART 2: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to execute such management agreement on behalf of the City of Abilene.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
