A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPOINTING NATHAN NEWMAN AS ASSISTANT MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE TO PRESIDE OVER THE MUNICIPAL COURT WHEN THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE IS ABSENT OR UNABLE TO PRESIDE OR WHEN THE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE IS VACANT.

WHEREAS, the present judge of the Municipal Court has resigned effective January 1, 1971, and has given notice that she will take her vacation time from December 14, 1970, to January 1, 1971; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint an Assistant Municipal Court Judge to preside in the Municipal Court until a new judge is appointed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene is of the opinion that Nathan Newman should be appointed Assistant Municipal Court Judge to preside until a judge of the Municipal Court is appointed; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

PART 1: That Nathan Newman be, and is hereby, appointed Assistant Municipal Court Judge to serve until a judge of the Municipal Court is appointed.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
