A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPOINT MR. JESS HOLLOWAY TO ACT AS MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE IN THE ABSENCE OF THE JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT AND THE ASSISTANT JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT.

WHEREAS, Nathan Newman, Municipal Court Judge of Abilene, Texas, and Richard Price, Assistant Municipal Court Judge, will be attending the Bar Convention on June 29, 1971, June 30, 1971, July 1, 1971, and July 2, 1971, and will be out of the City of Abilene on these dates; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Municipal Court of the City of Abilene continue in its operations and functions; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Jess Holloway, a qualified attorney, has agreed to act as Municipal Court Judge in the absence of Judge Newman and Mr. Richard Price; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to appoint Mr. Jess Holloway to act as Municipal Court Judge for June 29, 1971, June 30, 1971, July 1, 1971, and July 2, 1971.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
