A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF WATER TREATMENT CHEMICALS; MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice, as required by law for bids for the purchase of 700 tons liquefied chlorine gas; 20 tons liquefied aluminum sulphate; 30 tons ground aluminum sulphate; 30 tons pebble quicklime; 1,000 tons bulk quicklime; 20 tons activated carbon, bulk truck delivery; 20 tons activated carbon, hopper car delivery; 12 tons sodium hexametaphosphate; meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and,
