A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL FOR A GRANT TO FUND A CRIME PREVENTION UNIT IN THE ABILENE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas has established a Crime Prevention Program in an effort to reduce major crimes against property in Texas, and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas has requested the City of Abilene to participate in this program in cooperation with the cities of Odessa, Amarillo, Waco, Beaumont, and Corpus Christi, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas finds it advantageous and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Abilene to participate in this Governor's Crime Prevention Program; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City of Abilene will participate fully with the Governor's Crime Prevention Program along with five other cities as a pilot project in an effort to reduce major crimes against property, and be it further resolved,

PART 2: That the City of Abilene authorizes the submission of an application for a grant to fund a crime prevention program in the City of Abilene, and be it further resolved,

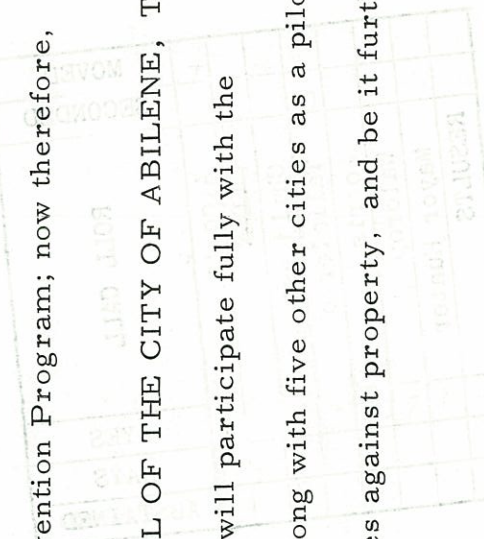
PART 3: That the City Manager is authorized to sign any instruments or documents to secure the grant and complete the program.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.

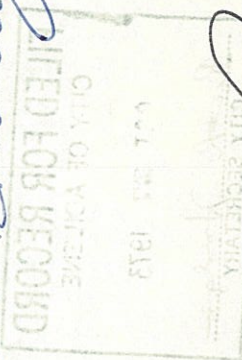
