A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF ABILENE TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL FOR THE PURCHASE OF CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION EQUIPMENT FOR THE ABILENE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has prepared an application to be presented to the Texas Criminal Justice Council in an effort to obtain a grant in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Two and 00/100ths (\$1,132.00) Dollars, for the purchase of criminal investigation equipment to be utilized by the Abilene Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene is of the opinion that the grant in question should be applied for and that the City Manager of the City of Abilene should be authorized to sign the application; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Manager of the City of Abilene is hereby authorized to sign an application for a grant from the Texas Criminal Justice Council in the amount of \$1,132.00 for the purchase of criminal investigation equipment, as shown by a copy of such application attached hereto.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
