AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A TRAILER AND WATER TANK, MEETING
SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as
required by law, for bids for the purchase of a trailer and water tank, meeting
specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on the 4th day of

February, A. D. 1975:
