A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,  
REAPPOINTING NATHAN NEWMAN MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE FOR A TERM OF  
TWO (2) YEARS.

WHEREAS, Nathan Newman was appointed Municipal Court Judge on April 8,  
1971; and,

WHEREAS, Nathan Newman was reappointed Municipal Court Judge on March  
8, 1973, said term expiring on March 8, 1975; and,

WHEREAS, Section 76 of the Abilene City Charter provides that the Municipal  
Court Judge be appointed for a term of two (2) years; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene is of the opinion that Nathan  
Newman has honorably served his community and should be reappointed for a new  
two (2) year term as Municipal Court Judge, beginning March 8, 1975; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene approves of the appointment  
of Nathan Newman as Municipal Court Judge of Abilene, Texas, and hereby authorizes  
the Mayor, J. C. Hunter, Jr., to appoint Nathan Newman as Municipal Court Judge  
for a term of two (2) years beginning March 8, 1975.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its  
passage.
