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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, REJECTING BIDS ON TWO (2) TRUCKS AND AUTHORIZING READVERTISEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4) TRUCKS, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised, and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of trucks, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received on August 19, 1975, as shown on the attached Exhibits "A" and "B"; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that bids received on two (2) trucks, as shown on Exhibit "A", should be rejected; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of International Truck Company, for the purchase of four (4) trucks, as shown on Exhibit "B", in the amount of Seventy-Four Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Eight and 76/100ths (\$74,238.76) Dollars, is the lowest and best responsible, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That bids received for two (2) trucks, as shown on Exhibit "A", be, and the same are hereby rejected, and the Purchasing Agent is authorized to readvertise.

PART 2: That the bid of International Truck Company, for the purchase of four (4) trucks, as shown on Exhibit "B", in the amount of \$74,238.76, is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 3: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to make such purchase from said company.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage. ADOPTED this 28th day of August, A.D. 1975.
