
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to make such purchases from said company.


PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
