The Railroad agrees that usage of said street shall be restricted to the actual switching of trains . In accordance therewith, the railroad agrees not to use said street for the permanent or temporary storage of freight cars or locomotives .

V

The Railroad agrees that usage of said street shall be confined, insofar as practical, to the hours during which parking is restricted by the City . Should additional usage time be needed, the Railroad agrees to rely upon voluntary removal of any cars blocking the tracks . The Railroad further agrees that except as provided by the Traffic Code of the City of Abilene, no cars shall be towed, pushed, pulled or otherwise removed .
