A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,  
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MICROFILM EQUIPMENT, MEETING  
SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave notice, as required  
by law, for bids for the purchase of microfilm equipment, meeting specifications,  
for use by the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received on June 1, 1976, as shown on the attached  
Exhibit "A"; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bid of Eastman Kodak  
Company, for the amount shown, is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting  
specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the bid of Eastman Kodak Company, for the purchase of microfilm  
equipment, in the amount of Eighteen Thousand One Hundred and 85/100ths (\$18,100.85)  
Dollars, is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and the same is  
hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to make  
such purchase from said company.

PART 3: That the sum of \$15,000.00 has previously been appropriated from  
Revenue Sharing Funds toward the purchase of said microfilm equipment therefore,  
it is now necessary to appropriate the sum of \$3,100.85 from General Budget Surplus  
to complete the transaction with Eastman Kodak Company.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
