

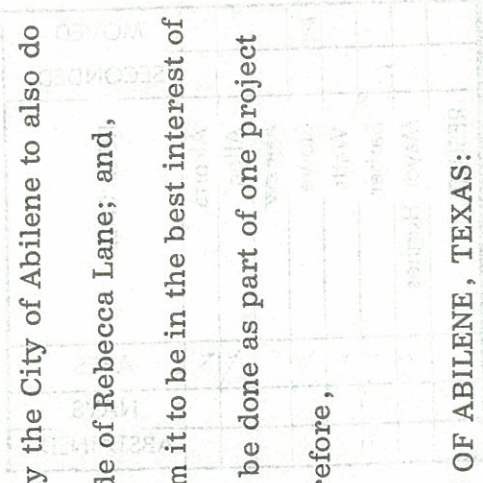

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AGREEING TO PAVE A PORTION OF REBECCA LANE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN ESCROW AGREEMENT TO SECURE PAYMENT.

WHEREAS, Countryside Estates, a joint venture composed of Nathan Morris, Trustee, J. B. Fooshee, Trustee, and United Financial Mortgage Corporation, is in the process of subdividing and developing a subdivision known as Countryside Estates of Abilene, Sections 1 and 2, and is required by the Subdivision Ordinance of the City of Abilene to provide for paving, curbing and guttering of the South side of Rebecca Lane from Buffalo Gap Road to the alley West of Bruce Drive; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene plans to assessment pave, curb and gutter the North side of Rebecca Lane; and,

WHEREAS, Countryside Estates has offered to pay the City of Abilene to also do the said paving, curbing and guttering of the South side of Rebecca Lane; and, WHEREAS, the City and Countryside Estates deem it to be in the best interest of both that the necessary paving, curbing and guttering be done as part of one project to reduce costs and prevent economic waste; now, therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: The City agrees to include in its assessment paving project and contract the paving, curbing and guttering of the South side of Rebecca Lane from Buffalo Gap Road to the alley West of Bruce Drive for which developer will pay City at the current assessment rates of \$8.00 per lineal foot.

PART 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized and instructed to execute the attached Escrow Agreement on behalf of and as the act and deed of the City of Abilene, Texas.

PART 3: This resolution shall take effect from and after its passage as provided by the City Charter.
