

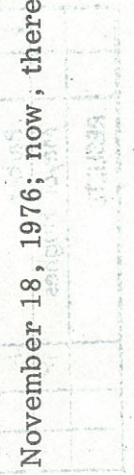

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPOINTING PHILIP L. WETHERBEE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE FOR A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS.

WHEREAS, there exists a vacancy for the position of Municipal Court Judge for the City of Abilene, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council Personnel Committee has solicited applications for the position of Municipal Court Judge from all qualified and competent attorneys licensed to practice law in the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council Personnel Committee, after examining the qualifications of the applicants, recommends to the City Council that Philip L. Wetherbee be appointed Municipal Court Judge of the City of Abilene, in accordance with the City Charter of the City of Abilene, effective November 18, 1976; now, therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby approves of the appointment of Philip L. Wetherbee as Municipal Court Judge of Abilene, Texas, and hereby authorizes the Mayor, Fred Lee Hughes, to appoint Philip L. Wetherbee as Municipal Court Judge for a term of two (2) years beginning November 18, 1976.

PART 2: That Philip L. Wetherbee be employed at a salary of Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Seven (\$16,527.00) Dollars, annually, as established by the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
