A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPOINTING A PANEL OF ASSOCIATE JUDGES TO ACT IN THE ABSENCE OR UNAVAILABILITY OF THE JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT.

WHEREAS, there are occasions when the Judge of the Municipal Court is temporarily unable to serve; and,

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Abilene provides for the appointment of Assistant Municipal Court Judges to act when the Municipal Judge is unavailable; and,

WHEREAS, the Judge of the Municipal Court has contacted the below listed panel of qualified and competent attorneys who have agreed to serve in his absence and recommends their appointment as Assistant Municipal Court Judges, in accordance with the City Charter of the City of Abilene, effective August 11, 1977; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby approves of the appointment of the following four (4) attorneys as Assistant Municipal Court Judges of Abilene, Texas, and hereby authorizes the Mayor, Fred Lee Hughes, to appoint this panel as Assistant Municipal Court Judges for a term of two (2) years beginning

August 11, 1977:

1. Ed Cockerell
2. Walt Morton
3. Jeff Lewis
4. John Saringer

PART 2: That these attorneys shall be paid only for the actual time that they shall serve as Assistant Municipal Court Judges.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
