amount of \$1,379.97 is the highest and best bid, and should be accepted; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: That the bid of Mark Giagola for the purchase of a 1940 Seagraves fire
