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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING A CORRECTION BID, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE PURCHASE OF A STATIONARY DIESEL ENGINE, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of November, 1977, the City Council of the City of Abilene accepted the bid of Watkins Service Co. for the purchase of a stationary diesel engine, in the amount of Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Five and 20/100ths (\$2,485.20) Dollars; and,

WHEREAS, an error was made in tabulating the bids and the actual bid was for Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Nine and 20/100ths (\$3,369.20) Dollars; and, WHEREAS, said bid is still the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the bid of Watkins Service for the purchase of a stationary diesel engine, in the amount of \$3,369.20, is the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 2: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to make such purchase from said company.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
